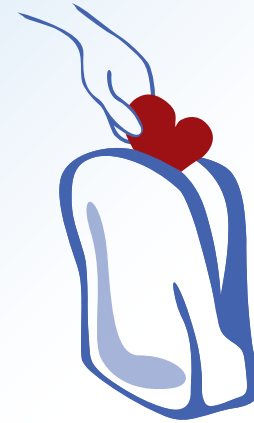

### Watertown Area PACH Program Facts

Of the 3,743 students in the Watertown School District - 1,184 are on free or reduced meals - indicating their families live at 150% of the poverty level or less. (WSD)

Of the 158 students in Henry - 52% qualify for free or reduced meals (2010 SD Kidscount)

Codington County had over 1,000 households receive supplemental nutritional assistance in 2010 and over 2,200 individual recipients. (2010 SD Kidscount)

Over 11% of the children in Codington County live in Poverty (2010 SD Kidscount)

The first backpack food program started in 1995 in Little Rock, Arkansas.

Many communities in South Dakota including: Brookings, Milbank, Vermillion, Pierre, Huron, Rapid City, and Sioux Falls have backpack food programs.
